ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY

1. LBC is committed to minimising the negative environmental impact resulting from building design, through advice to clients and control of building work under the Building Regulations.
2. LBC actively promotes the use of recycled materials, with the use of recycled paper wherever possible.
3. Printing is kept to a minimum with most data stored electronically (with controls in place for Data Protection).
4. LBC uses energy efficient equipment including eco-friendly computers to reduce energy consumption and lower heat production in our offices.
5. LBC encourages clients to specify materials and products that have no or low environmental impact, with products sourced from sustainable suppliers wherever possible.
6. LBC endeavours to work with sub-contractors and suppliers who have similar robust environmental policies.
7. LBC endeavoured to keep use of private or company vehicles to a minimum, with use of public transport encouraged where possible.
8. LBC sets environmental objectives and publishes them in the company's promotional literature.
9. LBC will communicate this policy to all our employees and ensure that they are given appropriate training to raise awareness of environmental issues.
10. LBC is committed to the implementation and continued review of this Environmental Policy
11. LBC continue with our 2021 commitment to support an 'Ecologi' initiative, which commits us as a company to plant a tree for every building control application received. The trees will be planted across the world as part of various projects to help reduce carbon emissions and this will reduce LBC's carbon footprint by an estimated 60 tonnes a month.
